Job Description

Position title: Field, Greenhouse and Market Crew

Description of duties:

The employee will work with a field crew of 3-4 people, five days a week. The employee will be responsible for working cooperatively with field crew in order to oversee operations of the farm on a day to day basis and keeping on task and working efficiently through all farm activities. Specific duties will include: managing field and greenhouse crops and their particular fertility and irrigation needs, and pest and disease pressures; greenhouse seeding, field seeding, transplanting and hand cultivation; managing CSA customer communications; record keeping, marketing and financial management; operation of compact tractor and equipment for primary and secondary field tillage and bed preparation; efficient harvest and post-harvest handling of produce.

All work will be conducted within the context of the LEAN, no-waste, high efficiency methods to increase profitability of the farm.

Responsibilities:

General

- Work cooperatively with farm crew on a daily basis to ensure seeding, planting, cultivation, irrigation, harvest and processing/packing deadlines are met
- Create, by example, a positive, co-operative and energetic work environment in which productivity and quality are emphasized
- Conduct field work, decision making and task management according to principles LEAN production.

Field Operations

- Assist in developing schedules for successive seedings/plantings of field crops, and ensure that they are followed on a weekly and monthly basis
- Monitor and manage weeding, irrigation and pest/disease control in a timely, pro-active manner
- Develop weekly produce lists to provide targets for harvesting and packing of all crops
- Efficient post-harvest handling of produce for market
- Oversee soil fertility though seeding of green manures and other inputs
- Maintain careful records of all planting, harvesting and crop/soil inputs
- Take responsibility for certain crops and areas of farm production (i.e. irrigation, pest management, etc.)

Office/Marketing

- Understand how to determine weekly produce lists to provide targets for harvesting and packing of all crops for market
- Prepare weekly produce and price lists for publication in the farm newsletter
- Administer weekly customer newsletter and respond to CSA e-mails
- Maintain production records on a weekly basis and in accordance with organic certification

requirements

Attend weekly farmers markets on a regular basis

- Preferably a post-secondary degree
- Basic financial capabilities
- Strong interpersonal and supervisory skills
- Familiar with organic production methods and organic standards
- Project management skills
- A positive, can-do attitude and a drive to work quickly and efficiently
- Consistently and reliably punctual
