

SUMMER RECREATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT

Hours:	70 Hours Bi-Weekly (16 weeks)
Wage:	\$12.55 per Hour

Applications must meet the following criteria:

- Be between 15 – 30 year of age (inclusive) at the start of employment.
- Is a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act, and
- Is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.
- Provide a current criminal record check.

Tasks and Responsibilities

- Assist in the delivery and development of seasonal/recreation programming to seniors and people with disabilities within a long term care setting.
- Assist with virtual visits.
- Therapy programming includes: horticultural, culinary, cultural, and intergenerational.
- Programs occur in one to one, small and large group setting.
- The individual is required to interact professionally with all levels of nursing staff as recreation is part of each person’s health care plan.
- Dealing with the elderly requires patience, understanding, tolerance and empathy.
- Leading groups of residents through recreational therapy events in a kind, compassionate, and supportive manner.
